



JOBIE BUCKS !!!

How does it work?

Each Bethel is responsible to keep track of the daughters "Jobie Bucks" they accumulate. Each Bethel should have an adult oversee the "Jobie Bucks" program. The timeframe for this program runs from Sunday Grand Sessions 2009 until May 31, 2010. Each daughter is allowed to carry over a **maximum of \$50.00** from last years accounts.

These "Jobie Bucks" are to be awarded to the daughters as they do certain things within the Bethel, or attend certain activities. The more activities a daughter attends the more "Jobie Bucks" she can receive. See below for further descriptions and examples on how to distribute the "Jobie Bucks".

How do I earn "Jobie Bucks"?

"Jobie Bucks" can be distributed through the Bethel at various activities (see suggestions below), or at state activities and even by our MJD, CONGO and GBHQ as they travel to each Bethel! But one great way that a daughter can earn more "Jobie Bucks" is by initiating new members! For each new member that is brought into the Bethel by a daughter, she will receive \$10.00 in "Jobie Bucks".



What do I do with these "Jobie Bucks"?

As you accumulate "Jobie Bucks", whether it be one, ten, twenty or more, hold on to them and visit the Jobie Store during its scheduled hours of operation (All state weekends at Patton Campus or order at anytime during the year) to purchase items with your "Jobie Bucks". How to use your "Jobie Bucks"?

Each Bethel is asked to give to EACH daughter who is attending the state weekend events a slip stating the daughters name and how much is in her account. As the daughters purchase their items, the Jobie Store will write down how much was spent and on what items. It is up to each Bethel to make sure those daughters hand back those slips and deduct appropriately from each daughters "Jobie Bucks" account with what and how much was used.

"Jobie Bucks" Awards Schedule

- \$1.00 – For paying Bethel Dues
- \$2.00 – For attending your Bethel meeting
- \$2.00 – For attending a Bethel Activity
- \$3.00 – For attending a Statewide Event
- \$3.00 – For helping with a Bethel Fundraiser
- \$4.00 – For attending another Bethel's Meeting/Activity
- \$10.00 – To each new initiate
- \$10.00 – For recruiting a new member (signing a petition)

Each Bethel can also award "Jobie Bucks" to any daughter who may have done an outstanding achievement for their Bethel. We recommend that you follow through with whatever that achievement was to other daughters to set a standard and example for your Bethel.

(Ex. Sally Jo handed in her "Jobie Bucks" slip after Grand Bethel Weekend without us having to ask her! We gave her \$2 in "Jobie Bucks" for showing responsibility for the program.). Please use your judgment carefully on extra awards with the "Jobie Bucks".
